**RECKSON/SL GREEN CELEBRATES EARTH DAY
AS TITLE SPONSOR OF PREMIER WESTCHESTER
AND CONNECTICUT EVENTS**

Sustainable Activities Planned from April 22nd to May 17th

White Plains, NY – April 11, 2014 – Reckson, a Division of SL Green Realty Corp. has announced, as part of its market leading sustainability program, in recognition of Earth Day 2014, it will participate as title sponsor for two premier environmental events, namely **White Plains Earth Week**, and **The Stamford Museum & Nature Center’s “Spring on the Farm Weekend”**.

On April 22nd, Reckson/SL Green will join the City of White Plains to celebrate **White Plains Earth Week**, a four-day environmental celebration, including community education, and preservation activities. The program culminates on April 26th with “Sustain White Plains,” a downtown open air street fair featuring sustainable exhibitors, organic food, technology and artwork created by 3D chalk artist Anthony Cappetto.

In conjunction with the New York Restoration Project (NYRP), tenants are invited to assist in park preservation, caring for trees and removing invasive plants with the goal of protecting this historic park.
